

Sailing Areas

Area A 1

European inland waters, rivers and canals, waters of the Baltic Sea, Kattegat and Skagerrak, North Sea, English Channel - with the boundaries running:

- 1) from the town of Thurso in the north of Scotland along the islands of Orkney and Shetland on the western side (three-mile zone) and continuing in a straight line to the entrance of the Trondheim Fjord, whereby travel in the Trondheim Fjord is also insured.
- 2) in a straight line from Land's End in the south of England, crossing the English Channel to the town of Brest on the continent.

Area A

as described under A 1 extending to include the Irish Sea as well as the adjacent waters of the Atlantic up to 65° North, 30° West and 20° North; the Mediterranean including the entire coast of North Africa, the Canary Islands, Madeira and the Azores, straits as well as the Dardanelles, the Black Sea and the Sea of Asov.

Area B

as described under A, waters of the Atlantic up to 40° South without any limitation to the west, including the adjacent waters of North America and Canada as well as the Caribbean.

Area C

Worldwide. This area is only insurable subject to prior written agreement.
